COMMITTEE	COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN	COMMITTEE DUTIES
 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE	Christine Giese ★	Provides leadership, planning, and oversight for the Washington County Republican Party. Working alongside the County Chair, the committee develops strategy, coordinates party activities, oversees committees, and recommends policies that strengthen the Republican Party throughout Washington County.
 VACANCY COMMITTEE	Alan Norton ★	Oversees the process for filling precinct chair vacancies and other party vacancies in accordance with Texas Election Code and county bylaws. Reviews applications, interviews candidates when appropriate, and makes recommendations to the County Executive Committee.
 RULES COMMITTEE	Emil Mokry ★	Reviews and recommends changes to county party bylaws and operating procedures. Interprets rules when questions arise, ensures meetings are conducted according to parliamentary procedure, and recommends policy updates to the Executive Committee.
 FINANCE COMMITTEE	David Eickhoff ★	Develops the annual budget, monitors income and expenses, recommends fundraising strategies, reviews financial reports, ensures compliance with campaign finance laws, and advises the County Chair on financial planning and stewardship.
 VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE	Lessie Kester ★	Recruits, trains, and coordinates volunteers for headquarters, events, voter registration drives, block walking, phone banking, Election Day activities, and special projects. Maintains volunteer lists and schedules.
 COMMUNICATION/ SOCIAL MEDIA COMMITTEE	Sonya Schulze ★	Manages the party's public communications, website, email newsletters, Facebook and other social media platforms. Promotes events, shares Republican messaging, coordinates press releases, and helps ensure consistent branding and timely communication with members and the public.
